

Climate Change Policy:

Aim: “to limit airport-related carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions”

LLAOL supports the UK Airport Operators Association’s Sustainable Aviation Strategy and its objectives, and in doing so commits to limiting its CO₂ emissions, by:

- reducing CO₂ emissions in airport controlled buildings by 7% versus 2006 benchmark.
- developing an action plan to achieve the above target.
- accurately measuring CO₂ from energy used on site, aircraft operations and ground transportation.
- adopting a proactive approach to energy management of airport buildings.
- increasing the proportion of renewable energy purchased, where practical.
- encouraging the use of more sustainable transport modes for employees, passengers and visitors to the Airport, with a view to reducing transport-related CO₂ emissions.
- raising awareness across the Airport for the need to reduce energy and minimise CO₂ emissions.
- identifying opportunities for partnership arrangements with airport business partners, with a view to reducing CO₂ emissions.
